## United Way Waterloo Region Communities distributes \$560,490 to local organizations through 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Emergency Community Support Fund

### Funds to support local Frontline Services

January 21, 2021, United Way Waterloo Region Communities (UWWRC) launched a second call for applications for the Emergency Community Support Fund (ECSF). The fund provides financial support to charities and other qualified donees adapting their frontline services to support vulnerable Canadians during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Government of Canada has released the balance of funding for ECSF which is being administered in collaboration with United Way Centraide Canada, Community Foundations of Canada and the Canadian Red Cross.

Today, UWWRC is pleased to share an update on the recipients of this second round of funding. UWWRC received over 34 applications for community programs and services that support vulnerable community members. To date, 30 organizations have been approved for a total of \$560,490 in addition to \$1,240,000 distributed during round 1 of ESCF funding during the summer of 2020.
