United Way Waterloo Region Communities distributes over \$4.6M to Waterloo Region in 2020

Funds supported 129 local agencies and programs

**Waterloo Region**-United Way Waterloo Region Communities (UWWRC) is pleased to announce the distribution of **\$4,600,753.55** to 129 local agencies and programs in Waterloo Region in 2020.

Funds distributed through UWWRC include donations via the COVID-19 Community Fund, which was created in March 2020 to respond to immediate community needs related to the pandemic, as well as UWWRC's General Community Fund, which was modernized in 2020 to be more responsive to all community needs and local solutions.

During the latter part of 2020, UWWRC's 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Holiday Giving Fund raised an unprecedented \$205,753 (including matching funds from a generous group of donors). Donors were able to choose how their funds were designated through <a href="UWWRC's new Shopping Cart technology">UWWRC's new Shopping Cart technology</a>. As part of new online innovations at UWWRC, this allows donors to decide where their donations are allocated based on specific existing or emerging needs in the community.

"It is very heartening to see, during a year when many experienced unforeseen difficulties, our community come together and support so many people in Waterloo Region", said UWWRC CEO, Joan Fisk, "It is only through the generosity of donors that many of our local support services and programs are still able to be there for those in need."
