United Way Waterloo Region Communities Distributes \$716,626 to 58 Local Organizations and Programs

Calling on more community support to help meet the needs of our friends and neighbours.

Waterloo Region – United Way Waterloo Region Communities is pleased to announce the distribution of \$716,626 to 58 local community organizations and programs this quarter, starting July 2023. Review of the 87 applications showed a full spectrum of needs; however, a trend was noted in increased requests related to mental health and social isolation in youth, with a significant intersection for community members who are Black, Indigenous and Racialized or living with disabilities.

"All the applications were good, really good", commented CEO Joan Fisk. "Selecting how to allocate funding is getting more difficult, with more applications and less dollars to work with. We are calling on more community support to help meet the needs of our friends and neighbours."

The Giving Report, published by CanadaHelps, reported that one in four Canadians, roughly 26% percent, expect to use charitable services this year to meet basic needs while national giving is down 12% from 2019 – 2021.

United Way grants funding, through an application process, to local agencies, four times per year. As a center of philanthropic excellence, they bring people and organizations together to meet community needs and tackle complex social issues.
